This concert kicks off an ambitious 4-year international commissioning project, Doppelgänger, which pairs world premieres from four renowned composers — Bent Sørensen, Lotta Wennäkoski, Anna Thorvaldsdóttir, and Thomas Adès — with four major works from the chamber music repertoire of Franz Schubert. Each season, the Danish String Quartet will perform a world premiere on a program with its doppelgänger — the Schubert quartet or quintet that inspired it. The VRS is delighted to be a co-commissioner of the Doppelgänger project.





He made his stunning VRS debut in 2012 and in the intervening years has transitioned from prodigy to celebrated career musician, earning comparisons with towering figures such as Horowitz, Cliburn, and Ashkenazy along the way.
